



Brock Babb Memorial Scholarship

Purpose

The Brock Babb Memorial Scholarship is an annual scholarship created by the National Tooling and Machining Foundation (NTMF) in support of students advancing their education and pursuing careers in manufacturing. Successful scholarship applicants will receive a minimum award of \$1,000. It is the intent of the NTMF to award these scholarships as-needed.

Selection

The NTMA Education Team shall serve as the selection committee, and shall make the final selection of the scholarship recipients from a list of those students that submitted complete and accurate applications following the criteria outlined in the Eligibility Requirements.

Eligibility Requirements

All Applicants Must:

- Be at least 18 years of age when the education program begins.
- Be a high school senior that is planning to attend an accredited educational facility; or be a high school graduate enrolled to continue his or her education in a manufacturing industry-related discipline.
- Reside in the United States, and attend, or are enrolled to attend, a trade school, technical college, apprenticeship, or an accredited college or university in the United States with the intention of completing manufacturing coursework.
- Submit a complete and accurate scholarship application and supporting documentation.
- Provide an official high school and college transcript (if applicable).
- Provide a written summary stating their career goals, interests, classes they plan to attend, any work-related activities, and any volunteering efforts, and why they believe they should receive the scholarship.
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a representative of an NTMA Member Company in good standing.
- Provide one additional letter of recommendation from a business or community professional (employers, teachers, coaches, clergy, etc.)

Award

The NTMF Brock Babb Memorial Scholarship funds will be paid upon proof of acceptance and enrollment into an appropriate education facility, as defined above.

Submission

A completed application and all supporting information must be submitted by April 1st.
